

So you think you want to join PBG?

Presbyterians for a Better Georgia is a partnership of the Presbytery of Greater Atlanta, consisting of member congregations. We support public policy to serve our most vulnerable neighbors. PBG achieves its goals by 1) educating member congregations on the issues, 2) engaging with congregations to be advocates in the sphere of public policy, and 3) advocating with our elected representatives at the Georgia General Assembly.

We accomplish our Mission by...

- **Partnering with a Public Policy Advocate** who works on behalf of the Partnership to influence legislation at the Georgia statehouse, and who supports and equips members of local churches to be effective policy advocates.
- **Congregational Training and Campaigns:** PBG helps its member congregations with effective advocacy campaigns important to their social mission.
- **Organizing Educational Events:** Volunteers from PBG member congregations host nonpartisan annual events, open to the public, to educate and inform Georgians about critical issues, meet legislators who are people of faith, and engage in conversation about the intersection of faith and politics.

How to Join:

1. Attend a PBG meeting
 - a. To begin the process of your congregation joining Presbyterians for a Better Georgia, we ask that you attend a PBG meeting or event. Congregational partners meet monthly and there are quarterly events.
2. Host a PBG staff presentation
 - a. A staff member of Presbyterians for Better Georgia will come and make a presentation to Session or a committee of Session (such as the mission or social justice committee).
3. Bring the proposal to join PBG to Session
 - a. Session must vote to approve the partnership.
4. Submit membership form and payment of annual dues
 - a. After Session approval, send in completed form and annual dues. Dues can be sent to the Presbytery office. Your congregational liaison should start attending monthly meetings.
